At this session, supported by the European Commission, you will have the opportunity to share with the participants an overview of your company products, services, and competencies.

The Elevator Pitch session is a dynamic approach to knowledge exchange. It is actually a unique opportunity for project leaders, academics, startups, SME's, innovative industries, and practitioners that have an innovative end-user oriented project idea to pitch their proposals and promote their ideas and/or competencies to potential Horizon 2020 project partners.

21 topics and sub-topics in the 2018 security calls for proposals are addressed ([see the list](#)). They cover areas such as:

- Prevention, detection, response and mitigation of combined physical and cyber threats to critical infrastructure
- Pre-normative research and demonstration for disaster-resilient societies
- Human factors, and social, societal, and organisational aspects
  - o to be disaster-resilient societies
  - o to fight against illegal trafficking and terrorism
  - o to improve border security
- Technologies
  - o for first responders
  - o to enhance the fight against crime and terrorism
  - o to improve border security
- Information and data stream management to fight against (cyber)crime and terrorism
- Demonstration of applied solutions to enhance border and external security

Contributors at this session will have 3 minutes to encapsulate their central and latest thoughts on the topics. After all the presentations have been given, contributors will have a discussion time to debate, refine ideas and share their knowledge and opinions with the aim of paving the way for future cooperation.
