

PROGRAMME

The event in 2020 will focus on the H2020 Work Programme 2020 for the “Secure Societies - Protecting freedom and security of Europe and its citizens”. All delegates are invited to present their proposals and ideas for each topic of the Work Programme which are open in 2020. The delegates will get the opportunity to receive feed-back from practitioners in a dedicated roundtable, to discuss lessons learnt and what to expect for the future of the EU Security Research programme.

The interactive sessions will be divided into two “strands”: project presentations and brokerage meetings.

The interactive sessions will be organised in 7 main thematic areas:

- Protecting the infrastructure of Europe and the people in the European smart cities
- Border and External Security
- Disaster Resilient Societies
- Fight Against Crime and Terrorism
- Artificial Intelligence and security
- General Matters
- Digital Security

Each session will include the following 3 steps:

1. A short presentation of the theme and a walk through the topics that are covered.
2. Short presentations of contributions for new proposals by the delegates. Priority will be given to presentations by potential coordinators.
3. Brainstorming and networking on new project ideas and consortia in dedicated groups. During this “brokerage part” of the event, participants are able to meet other interested delegates and discuss their ideas and try to form a consortium.
