

## Instructions for Presentations

### Please read this section carefully!

The presentations will be selected by the co-chairs of each session and therefore it is essential that they are submitted before the deadline, 3 January 2020. *Presentations received after this deadline will not be taken into consideration.*

You will receive an email by 10 January, confirming that you have been selected to present after you have submitted your presentation.

### For presentation of a proposal for a specific topic in the work programme:

All presentations should give a short summary of contributions or ideas for new proposals. Please carefully select your contribution(s) bearing in mind the limited time available. Potential consortia must be open for entry from other participants. Priority will be given to presentations by potential coordinators.

#### Instructions:

- The presentation be submitted on using the SMI2G template (download template here [[LINK TO DOWNLOAD TEMPLATE FOR PRESENTATIONS](#)]), and should not be longer than 3 slides.
- You will have maximum 4 minutes to present the proposal.
- The name of the presentation, for when you are saving it, should be the reference for the topic which the presentation refers to, and followed by the name of the participant who will present it (e.g. SU-BES01\_MORGAN)
- We recommend you present the status of your consortium and what capabilities (or type of partners) you seek.
- You should not give a company descriptions or address multiple topics. If you have proposals for several topics, you must register and submit a presentation for each.

A list of the sequence of the presentations for this session will be distributed before the meeting.
