36 reserve GAPs have been opened:


- 27 ETN



ITN 2019: Main Changes and Novelties

Evaluation:

ITN

- **Improved briefing for experts**: web-briefing with 4 animated videos, 3 manuals for evaluators (1/mode)
- **Dedicated experts per mode** (EID/EJD/ETN)
- **Scheduling** given to evaluators so that CR discussions can start as soon as the 3 IERs are submitted (balanced workload)
- SEP workflow and functionalities adjusted to ease the remote consensus discussion (teleconference system integration tests (approx. 5% of the proposals)



ITN 2019 Submission



•1565 proposals submitted

•Decrease of 5.6% compared to ITN 2018 (- 93 proposals), 12% decrease for EID, 2.3% increase for EJD, 4.2% decrease for ETN


•With a budget of €470 million, ITN is expected to fund about 150 projects supporting more than 1,900 young researchers, with an anticipated overall success rate around 9.5%.





IF 2018 Submitted & Main list proposals











More male researchers applicants (59%) than female (41%)

- Highest female % SOC (55%), LIF (49%), ENV (45%)
- Highest male % in ENG (79%), PHY (78%), MAT (75%)


More male researchers in the Main list (55%) than female (45%)

But, female researchers are more successful than male researchers





1st WF call 2018



Objective: to provide specific support to excellent researchers not funded through the IF call to undertake an individual fellowship in a widening country

Budget: EUR 5 million (respectively EUR 6 and 7 million for 2019 and 2020) from the *"Spreading Excellence and Widening Participation"* Work Programme.

Evaluation: Proposals considered for WF funding if:

- admissible and eligible for MSCA IF
- obtained a score of 70% or above in the MSCA IF call but was not funded under that call
- have not opted out from consideration for WF call



Widening countries: 773 proposals submitted in IF 2018























Success rate in IF for widening countries: IF 2017 8,6% IF 2018 6,5% => 10,7% IF + WF

WF 2018: +66 % of projects to be funded with a widening host.








Total funded proposals (IF + WF)

WF 2018



- 45 proposals opted out from the WF call (5,8%)
- 402 proposals received a score of 70% or above, but were not funded under call MSCA- IF-2018 call
- 33 proposals retained for funding

Excellence prevailed:

- Experts evaluated all proposals regardless of the type of action/country of origin of the applicants (i.e. WF proposals evaluated on equal footing as IF)
- scores of proposals retained for funding range from 90.2 to 92.6




EU contribution (in thousand €)


Number of participants
