Main EU programme for structured doctoral training

Train a new generation of creative, entrepreneurial and innovative early-stage researchers

- **Triple "i" dimension (international, interdisciplinary and intersectoral)**
- **Knowledge triangle (education – innovation – research)**
- **Employability – entrepreneurial skills**
- **Exchange of best practise among participating organisations**

European Training Networks (ETN)

- The most general mode, epitomising the ITN policy objectives
- Does not require mandatory doctoral training

European Industrial Doctorates (EID)

- Focus on academic/non-academic collaboration
- Widening fellows' career horizons

European Joint Doctorates (EJD)

- Promoting greater structural co-operation between universities
- Offering more employment opportunities to fellows
