








StG 2012 - 2014 – Overview by domain

Submissions by gender




StG 2013 - 2014 - Overview by domain

Submissions vs passed to Step2 by gender







Step 1 success rate by gender









Resubmissions from previous calls





Resubmissions : success rates from previous calls








StG 2014 – results of Step 1 Success rate by HI country




Overview: CoG 2014

- Final number of submitted proposals 2528
- Eligibility finished 36 ineligible proposals (rate of ineligibility 1.4%)
- Step 1 Panel Meetings just completed for all domains
- Communication to successful Step 1 applicants for interview gone out, together with an informal notice to unsuccessful PIs
- Step 2 meetings November / December 810 interviews to be held




COG 2014 Ineligibility

ERC COG 2014 Reasons for ineligibility 36 proposals = 1.4 % (1.6 % in 2013)














CoG 2014 - Step 1 results *SH domain: panel budget multiplier

COG 2014 - Submissions by gender


ERC COG 2013 - 2014 % submissions from females by panel









- 123 Grantees re-applying overall step 1 SR: 65%
- 31 StG 2007, 57 StG 2009, 34 StG 2010, 1 StG 2011
- 4.9 % evaluated proposals
- Highest PE2 @ 9
- PE 29 out of 52 passed to step 2 (SR = 56% vs PE domain 31 %; 3 proposals with C score)
- LS 36 out of 49 passed to step 2 (SR = 73% vs LS domain 37 %)
- SH 15 out of 22 passed to step 2 (SR = 68% vs SH domain 29%)

ERC PoC 2014-DL1 Overview






ERC Proof of Concept Evolution of Success rates and Budget used




ERC Proof of Concept 2011-2012-2013-2014 - Success rates by domain




ERC Proof of Concept 2014- DL1 Results PoC funded proposals by related Panel (Black Main; Red reserve)



EPICUP- EPIgenetics of Cancer of Unknown Primary

Fundacion Instituti de Investigacion Biomedica de Bellvitge (IDIBELL) ES.

The objective: to develop a package demonstrating the feasibility of a high-throughput tool for epigenotyping Cancer of Unknown Primary (CUP) to identify tumor type based in the DNA methylation profile of non-coding RNA (ncRNA) loci.(a diagnostic kit)



Relation with ERC grant:

The goal of the ERC grant is to determining the contribution of DNA methylation alterations to the aberrant activity of ncRNA loci in human cancer. Proved to be commercially feasible

ChildCog:Novel digital solutions for assessing child cognitive function (SH4)

Tampere University (FI)

The issue: Need to detect early child mental and cognitive functions.

Relation with ERC grant:

A central goal of the PIs ERC StG project



Europear

(EarlyDev) is to use electrophysiological and eyetracking based methods to probe infants' cognitive function

iPublic:Inkjet Printed Ultrafast Batteries and Large Integrated Capacitors

KTH Royal Institute of Technology (SE)

The issue: Present energy storage devices generally suffer from either low power density or low energy density. The PI proposes "graphene-buffered Li-ion batteries".



Relation with ERC grant: On the ERC grant the PI developed inkjet printing techniques, mainly relying on a solvent-exchange ink formulation technique, allow a reliable fabrication of uniform graphene patterns at a resolution of ~50 µm








ITN 2014: Submitted & A-list proposals




ITN 2014: Eligible and A-list proposals by panel





ITN 2014: Number of beneficiaries in A-list & Role






ITN 2014: Number of beneficiaries in A-list & Mode






ITN 2014: Number of partner organisations A-list & Mode




ITN 2014 - Number of EID beneficiaries & Role







RISE 2014: Success rates by participants and country (MS, AC, IEIO)




