1) **PROJECT INFORMATION**

Field of expertise related to the topic: Klea Faniko is senior lecturer at the universities of Geneva and Neuchâtel. Her research focuses on discrimination, diversity policies, and commitment of men in favor of gender equality. She is in charge of a European Project led by the Equal Opportunities Office (University of Geneva) promoting the transfer of diversity policies from the academia to business community and vice versa. She is the author of the study "Academic Careers and Sexism at the University of Geneva" documenting for the first time in Switzerland the presence of sexism and sexual harassment in academia. She is also a member of the working group implementing the campaign against sexual harassment at the University of Geneva. She has served as a consultant and trainer for a variety of organizations in Switzerland. At the University of Geneva, she initiated





different intervention programs aiming at raising the awareness about the impact of biases and stereotypes affecting different groups of people such as the summer school "Prejudice, discrimination, and the diversity challenge" and the continuing education "Promoting Equality and Diversity in the Professional World".

Potential contribution to the project: To assess through quantitative and qualitative research how people react toward sexism when they experience it or when they are a witness of sexism in different contexts (e.g., between academic staff members, between academic staff members and students, and between students)

-To design training programs which provide participants with tools and methods to identify and to react against sexism and sexual harassment at the University
