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

## FLAG-ERA context and main objectives



- FLAG-ERA main objectives: Support the Flagship programme and in particular the first two Flagships through
  - Dedicated Joint Transnational Calls (JTC 2015, JTC 2017, JTC 2019)
  - Support to partnering projects and to their integration into the Flagship



#### Need for a unifying goal


- Mentioned 7 times in the call text
  - built around a visionary unifying goal
  - the unifying goal, the grand S&T challenge and the underlying vision
  - the Flagship's unifying goal and its underlying S&T roadmap
  - A consolidated vision based on a well-defined unifying goal
    - articulated in terms of S&T objectives and of its targeted impact on economy and society
  - how the unifying goal can be realised
  - target a visionary unifying goal
  - bring together the relevant communities to address the unifying goal
- The unifying goal should be immediately understandable
  - Expressed in a short catch phrase
  - SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound)








#### Need for a flexible consortium agreement

- Need to provide a common framework for partners funded from various sources in addition to the Core Project
  - Mechanisms to manage the entry of associated partners
  - Associated partners integrated as much as possible except when needed to ensure the smooth running of the Core Project
- Need to provide a modular framework for managing subspaces with different confidentiality arrangements in addition to a Flagship-level forum
  - Mechanisms to manage the creation of such sub-spaces
  - Elaborated intranet structure


Combining efforts from multiple sources of funding
