Issue: upgrading energy efficiency over a scale of 4000 social housing, all in individual or detached houses, over the next 10 years, in an area where 44% of households are in energy poverty.

- The financial incentives are in place, as the criterias for ensuring the quality of the renovations. The program is part of a larger regional program covering 23000 housing to be refurbished over the next 10 years.
- A chain of partner organization has been set up so as to train the existing and future workforce in EE buildings
- A partnership has been built to help local building companies to respond to the tenders over the next ten years
- A cluster around EE building is active and has been for 17 years on the whole regional territory
