



- **High quality maintained, coherence ensured**

















Country participation under H2020 (all modes)








Top-10 Country participation under H2020 per mode & per mio capita





IF 2019: statistics –some conclusions

The majority of retained proposals – SOC panel (+21,0% increase), while in previous years it used to be LIF panel.

- SOC and LIF panels represent the majority of proposals selected for funding (50,5% for both panels combined).

However there are big differences across types of action:

- In **ST - LIF** (231) is slightly bigger than SOC (227)
- In **GF - SOC** is by far the biggest ranking list (80), followed by LIF (36)
- In multidisciplinary ranking lists, the largest number of retained proposals are:
 - ❖ In **RI - LIF** (67), followed by ENV (19)
 - ❖ In **CAR - SOC** (48), followed by LIF/ENV (23)
 - ❖ In **SE - LIF** (24), followed by ENG (13)










IF – under H2020 – researchers' nationality in submitted proposals

IF – under H2020 – success rate per host country











RISE 2020 participation by country











Panel breakdown












RISE under H2020 – Overall Statistics - Duration of secondments




Number of successful proposals per country



Doctoral Programme – 13 Main List proposals






















COFUND Fellow Data – Mobility
