# MSCA goals

- **Funding** (grants) = all career stages, all nationalities, all fields of research
- **Training** = unique skills and experience for career in public or private sector
- **Opportunities** = Good working conditions/benefits, mobility countries, sectors, disciplines
- **Sustainability** = collaboration between individuals and institutions



# Key Features

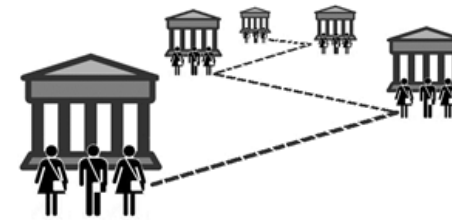


- Entirely bottom-up
- Open to all domains of research and innovation from basic research up to market take-up and innovation services
- Participation of non-academic sector strongly encouraged, especially industry and SMEs
- Mobility as the key requirement - funding on condition participants move from one country to another
- (Almost) no nationality conditions
- Promotion of attractive working and employment conditions
- Particular attention to gender balance
- Public engagement of supported researchers
- Annual calls (except for NIGHT – biennial)

## MSCA to foster excellence throughout Europe

### Objective

✓ stimulate regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development

### Scope

✓ international, intersectoral and interdisciplinary **research training**, as well as transnational and cross-sector **mobility** of researchers at all stages of their career

✓ Possibilities of synergies with structural funds

✓ Opportunities for **researchers from all countries**

✓ Researchers to comply with the mobility rules of the MSCA

✓ Open and transparent recruitment, vacancies widely publicised

### Expected Impact

✓ exploit synergies between European Union actions and those at regional, national, and international level

✓ leverage funding and combat fragmentation

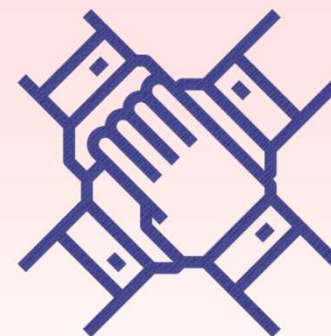

# COFUND in practice



- **Applicant** = Mono-beneficiary (EU MS or AC institutions) with max. 10 million EUR per call
- **Project duration** = between 3 and 5 years (n.b. fellowships min 3 months)
- **Recruitment** = EURAXESS

# COFUND – Main Features



- ✓ **Budget:** € 100 Million in 2020 (Doctoral Programmes: 40 Mio)
- ✓ Maximum **€ 10 Million per single applicant** per call
- ✓ Duration of projects: minimum 3 years, maximum 5 years (including the time taken to publish calls and recruit researchers)
- ✓ **Fellowships: minimum 3 months**
- ✓ EU contribution to cover **living allowances for researchers and management costs**
- ✓ Minimum living allowance fixed in the WP

# COFUND – Main Features



- ✓ Each single application must only address the doctoral or fellowship programme, but
- ✓ More than one application can be submitted
- ✓ Recruited researchers must respect the same mobility rule as IF (for the fellowship programme) or ITN (for the doctoral programme). Existing programmes can continue with own mobility rule if well-justified.
- ✓ Unless prohibited by national legislation all fellows, including doctoral fellows, must be recruited on a work contract.
- ✓ In the doctoral programme all fellows must be registered for a PhD



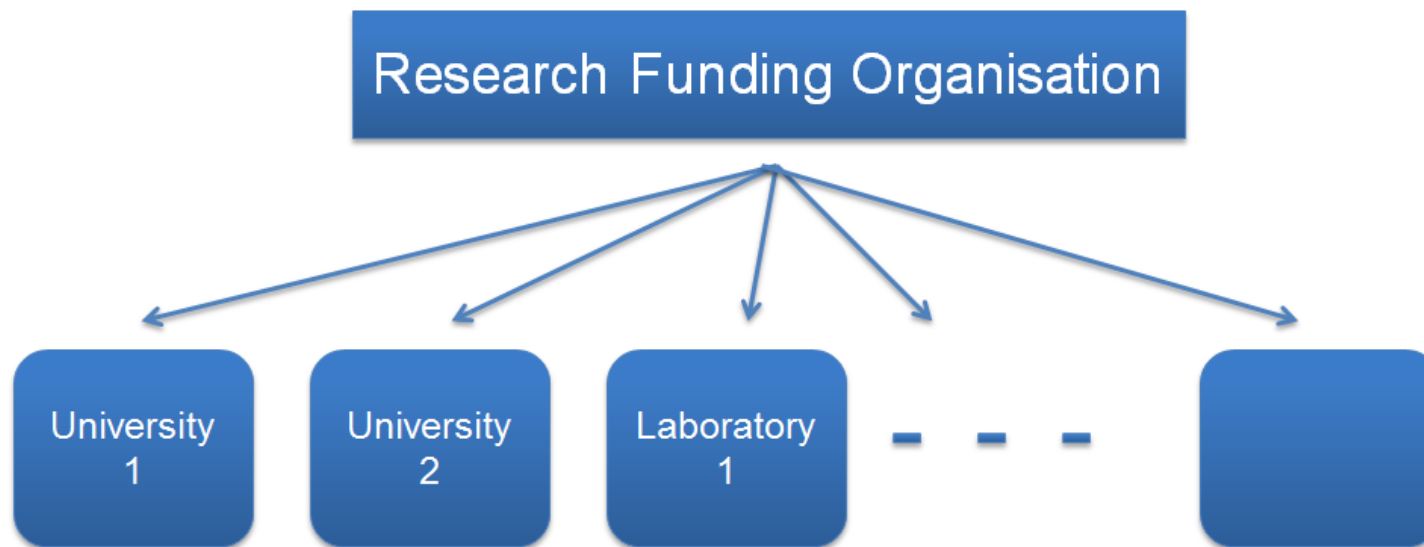
## Synergies with European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF)

- ✓ Support regional policies by internationalisation of human resources in research
- ✓ Possibility to support programmes that prioritise specific scientific disciplines based on smart specialisation strategies
- ✓ Cost items other than living allowance and management (such as research costs, travel and mobility allowances, overheads) may be funded through other resources including EU programmes other than Horizon 2020 (e.g. ESIF)



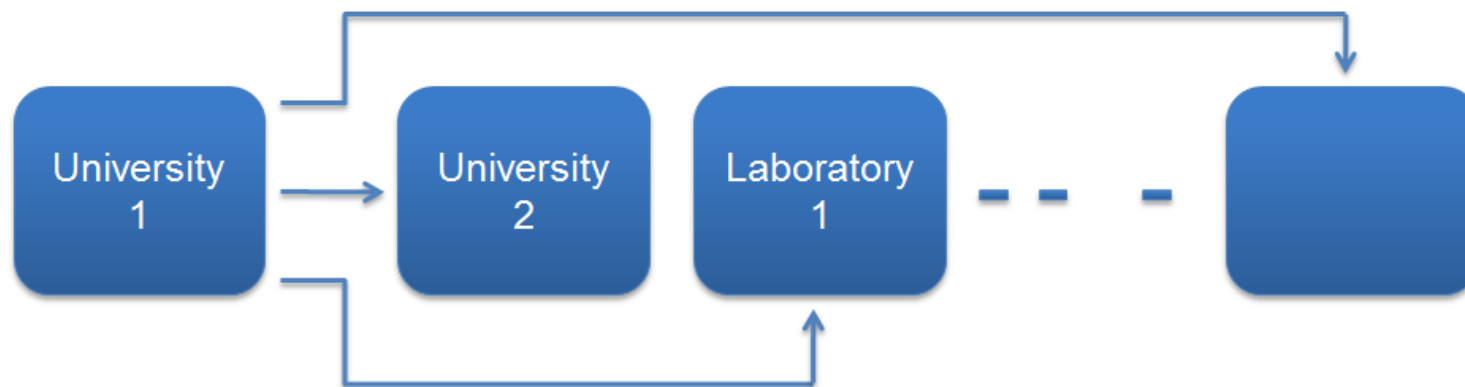

# COFUND – EU contribution



- ✓ EU contribution to **living allowance** for contracts with full social security:
  - Early stage researchers (ESR): € 1935 per person-month
  - Experienced researchers (ER): € 2740 per person-month
- ✓ EU contribution to **management costs**: € 325 per person-month

- ✓ Minimum amounts for monthly living + mobility allowances:

- ESR: € 2709
- ER: € 3836

- ✓ Other cost items may be funded through other resources (including ESIF funds)

Example (Fellowship programme – ER)

Cost item	Total cost [€ per person-month]	EU contribution [€ per person-month]
Living allowance	4800	2740
Mobility allowance	500	
Research costs	500	
Management costs	600	325
Indirect costs	600	
Total	7000	3065

## COFUND – EU contribution



To put the previous example in another way:

- The living allowance and management costs are 5400 EUR and the EU contributes 3065 EUR to this
- The remaining 2335 EUR in this category can come from any source, except EU funding.
- The mobility, research and indirect costs are 1600 EUR and these can come from any source except H2020 (but including ESIF)



# COFUND – EU contribution



NB – in the exceptional case where fellows are recruited on a stipend the EU COFUND contribution is further halved

## COFUND PROJECTS – SUCCESS FACTORS

- Interdisciplinary, intersectoral and international dimension.
- Solid co-funding mechanism.
- Wide and diversified network.
- Impact at individual and institutional level.

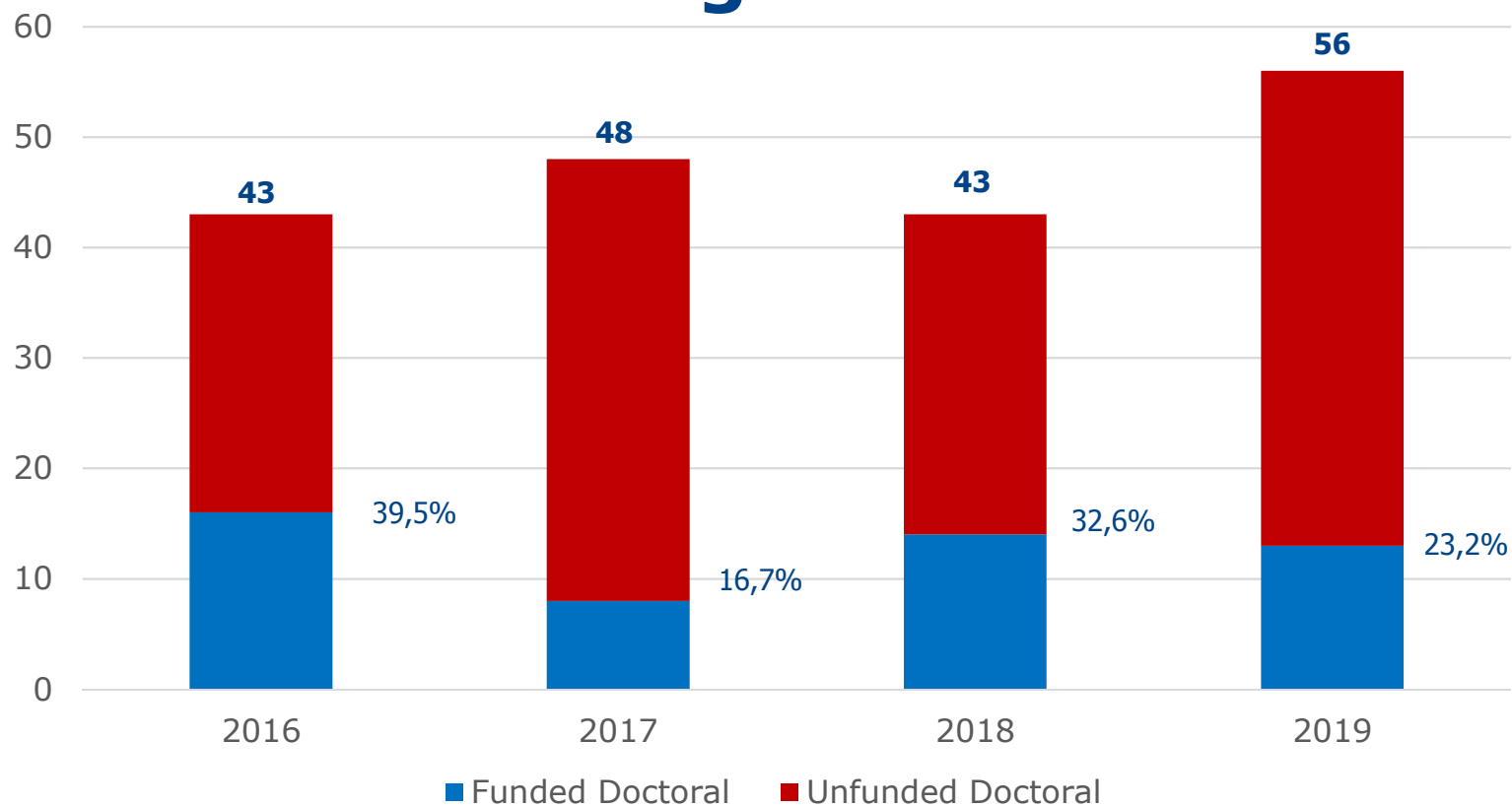


## LESSONS LEARNED FROM COFUND IMPLEMENTATION

- Successful proposals are based on high-quality peer-reviewed selection processes and provide a wide range of opportunities, including secondments and complementary training, to the researchers.
- Proposals involving networks of institutions – both national and international – offer much more choice to the researcher.
- Recurrent issue: transparency and fairness of selection procedures.

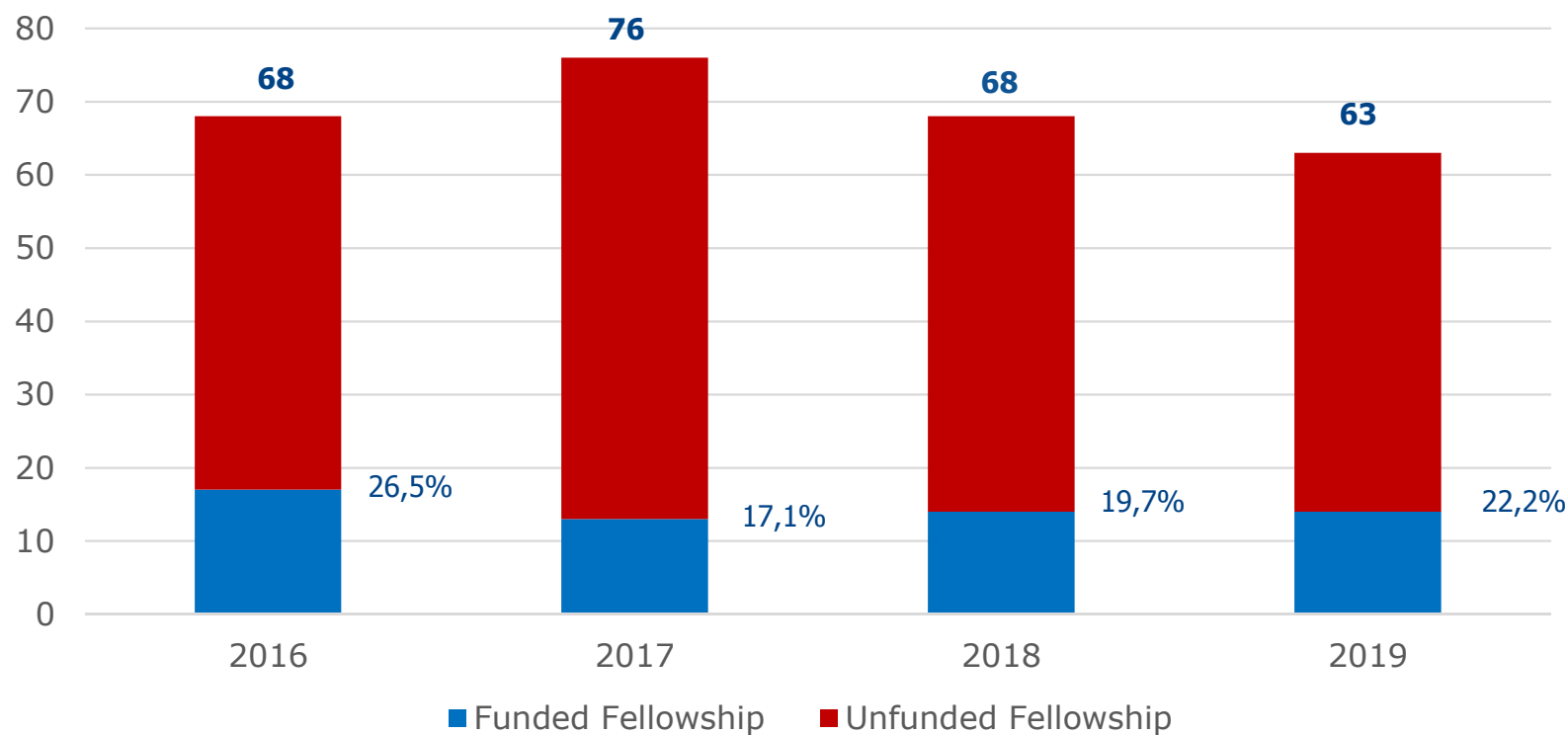


# Success Rates Doctoral Programme



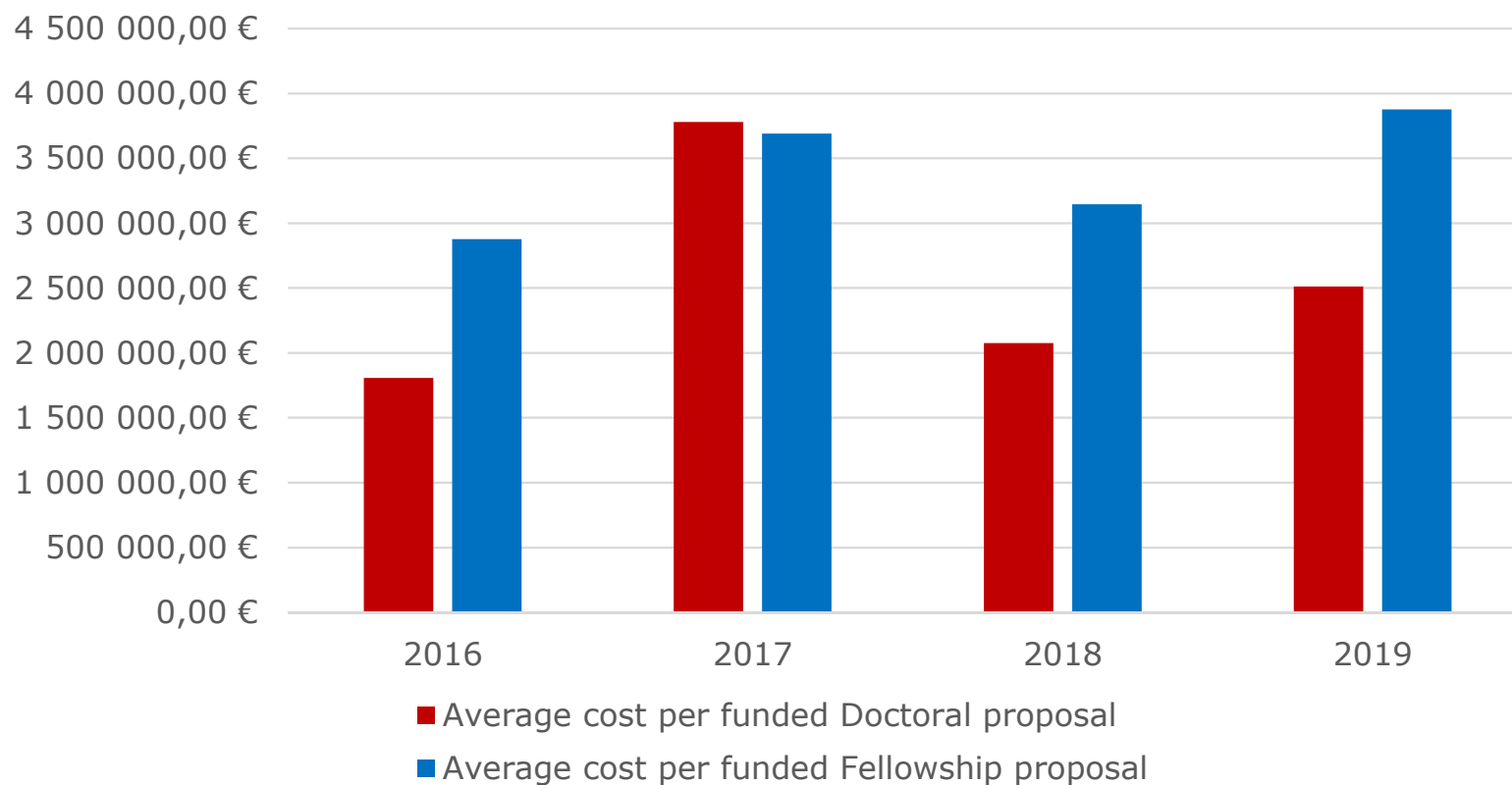


# Success Rates Fellowship Programme





# Average Proposal Costs (EU Contribution)



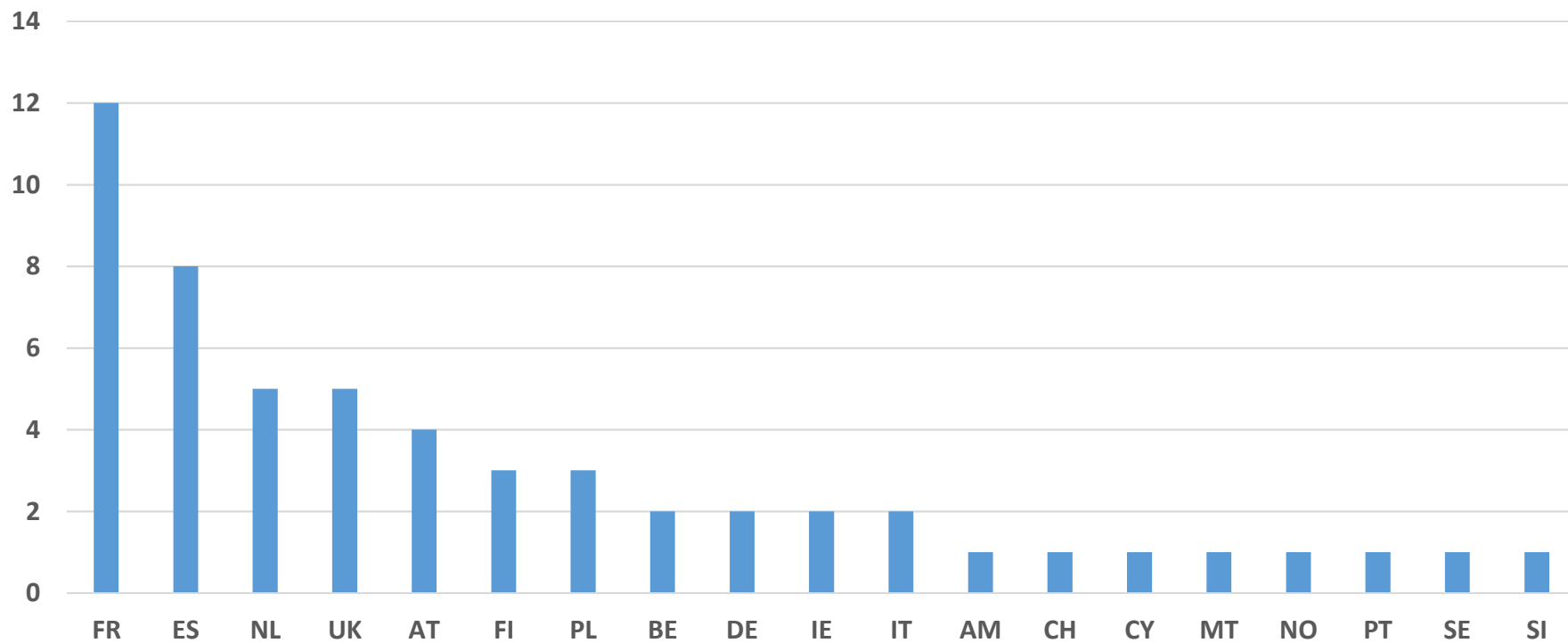

Number of proposals per country:



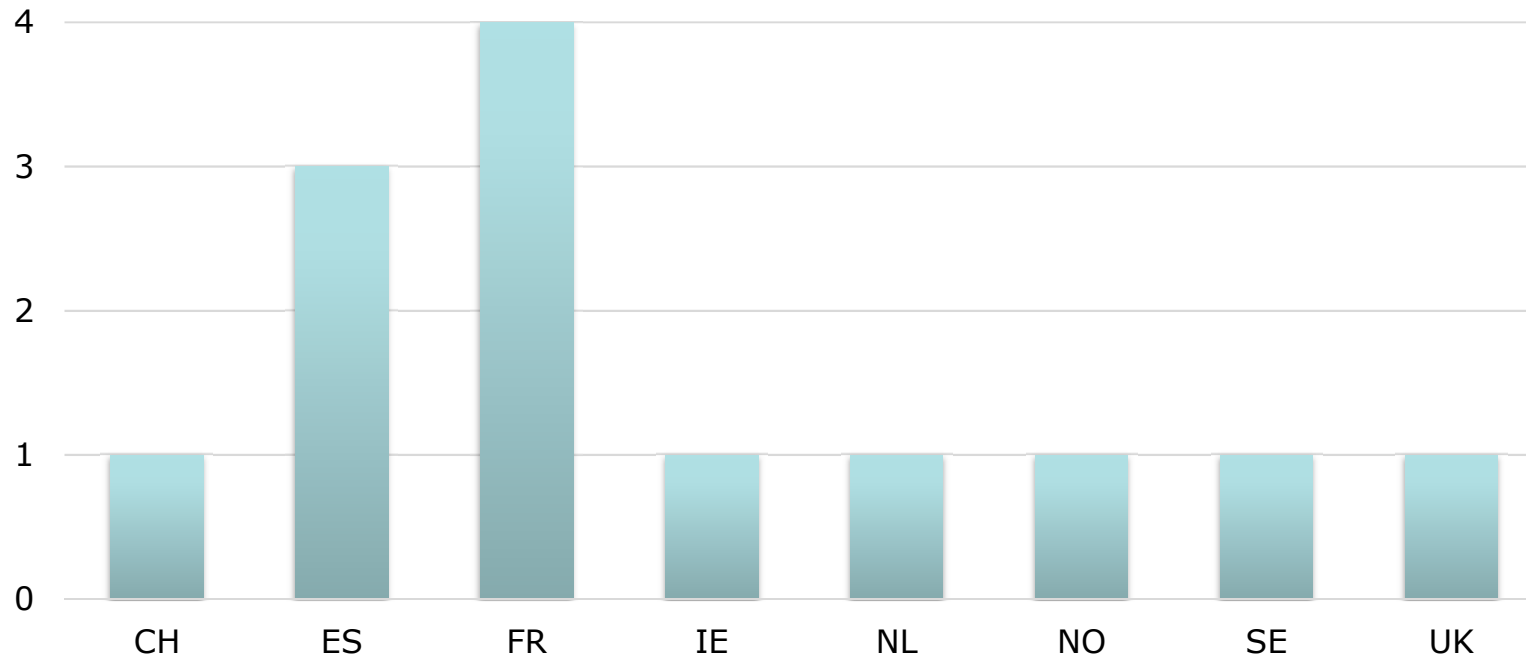




## Doctoral Programme – 13 Main List

### Number of successful proposals per country

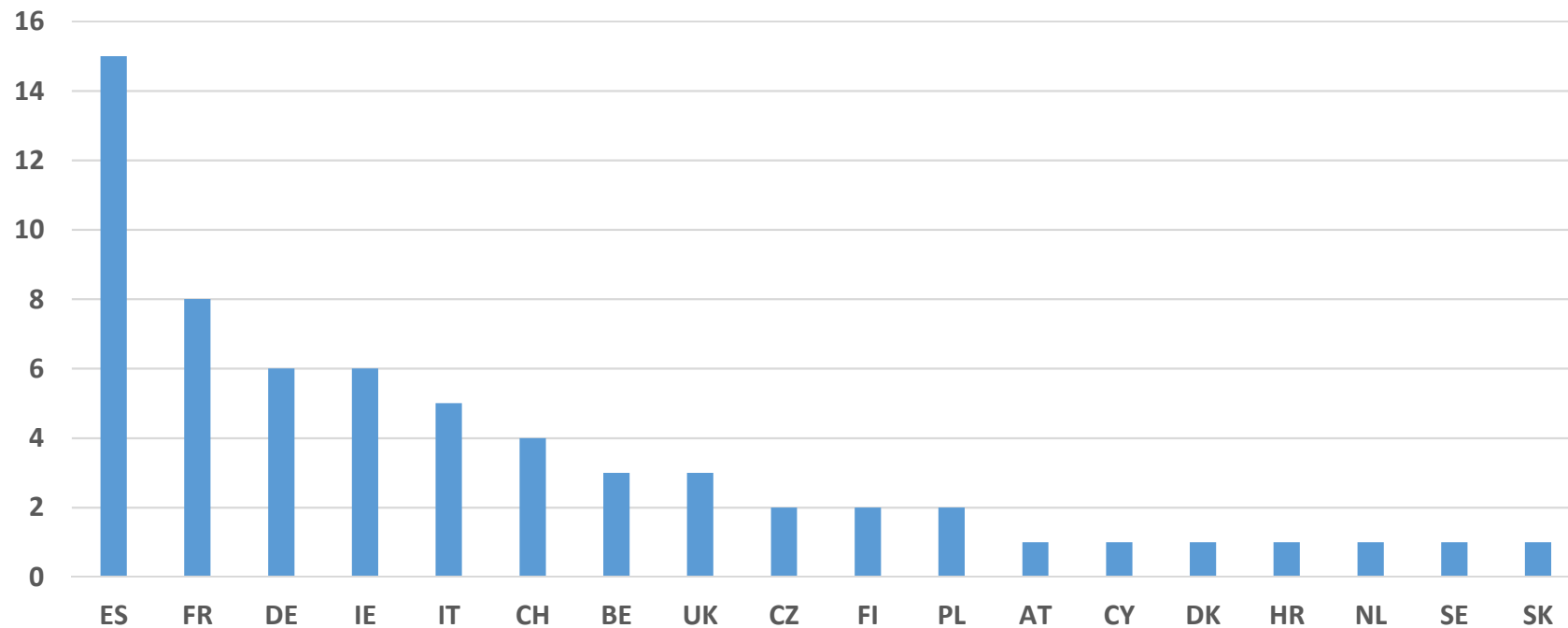




## Fellowship Programme – 63 eligible proposals

Number of proposals per country:

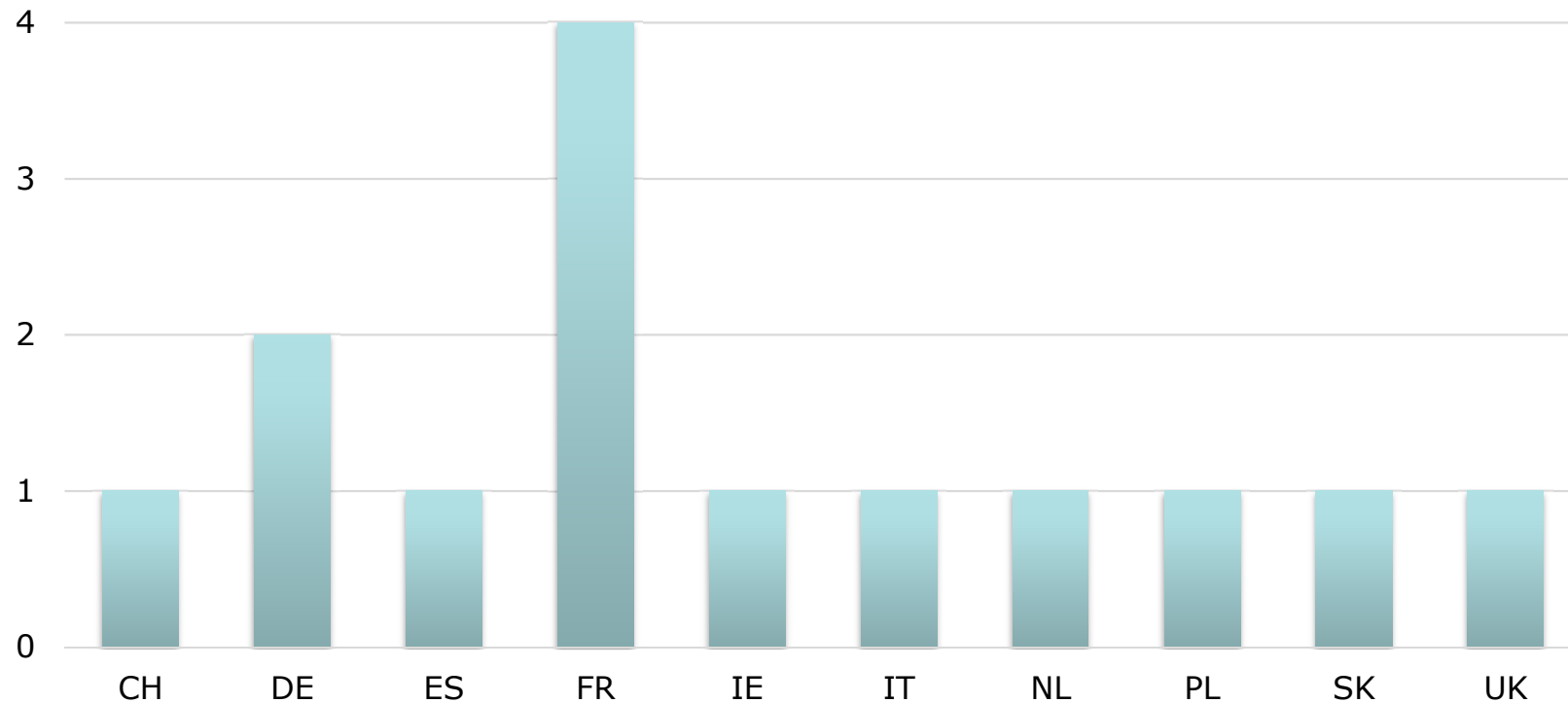




## Fellowship Programme – 14 Main List
