# PROPOSAL PREPARATION IS KEY



- Center your proposal on the postdocs: what is in it for them? How will your program advance their career? What are you offering in addition to excellent research?
- Well defined call for applicants with very clear selection criteria, as independent as possible – convince the evaluators you want to hire the best postdocs, not your previous students or other people from your network
- Take care of the details and cover every aspect of each section. Everything you miss results in a weakness and a loss of precious points
- o If you go for a multi-university program, start preparing early: lots of information to compile and many decisions to take. *Warning*: mono-beneficiary Grant Agreement
- Get advice from your National Contact Point
