Mobility: The recruited researcher must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the host organization for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the deadline for submission of proposals.

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

COFUND

The COFUND scheme aims at stimulating regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development.

- Multi-annual support for doctoral or fellowship programmes.
- Co-financing up to 50% by the European Commission.
- Promote research, training and mobility across borders, sectors and disciplines.



Who?

Organisations funding or managing doctoral

or postdoctoral fellowship programmes.

What?

Up to 50% co-financing for 3-5 years. Member States or Associated states.

When?

Call deadline every year!

Follow the call description

Make sure you are in line with the actions' programs objectives and rational.

Follow the quideline's instructions

Use the structure provided in the template and address all the evaluation criteria.

Excellence

Clear Criteria

Have a clear criteria for judging merit (with weights per criterion).

Spread the news

Advertise programme vacancies (internationally) using a range of means, especially in media relevant to the scientific field.

Careful selection

The selection committee should be transnational (at least partly) and potential conflicts of interest should be clearly addressed.

A clear and transparent process

Support to applicants through the entire application/ selection process e.g. with clear eligibility rules, a guide for applicants, clear feedback.

Impact the ERA

Outline the potential scientific impact on the European Research Area.

Start early and submit the right proposal on time



Impact

Embrace transnational mobility

Outline efforts to attract non-nationals and the support given.

Equal opportunities

Have an equal opportunities policy in place addressing career breaks and gender.

Training and development

Have a programme for complementary skills training and/or use Individual Career Development Plans to help broaden and deepen the fellows careers.

Maintain relationships

Set up an alumni network, it can help develop transnational links of fellowships and support fellows after they leave the programme.

What, how and by who?

Make sure the scale of the programme is credible and its implementation clearly described.

Get an impartial view

An impartial view from your colleague can add clarity and help eliminate week points

Implementation

Attract excellence

Offering competitive employment conditions, including social security benefits and/or excellent working conditions will help you to attract high quality applicants.

A vision for the future

Have a strategy for the continuation of the programme beyond the phase of EU co-funding.

Be client-friendly

A client-oriented application procedure with support for applicants, FAQ and feedbacks.

Emphasize your strong points

Outline administrative capacities for implementing and supporting fellowships.
