The EU membership of Cyprus makes it important in the School's view to promote EU projects such as European exchange and Life Long Programmes including Erasmus+. In addition to this programme, students are also encouraged to participate in the European Youth Parliament, and various Model United Nations including MEDI.M.U.N (Nicosia), MUNISH (The Hague) and PS-MUN (Athens) as well as the Junior Achievement Bi-communal Innovation Camp and Company Programme. Through such activities, which contribute enormously to self-esteem and maturity, students are taught to respect each other's cultures, and the Cypriot culture within which they are living whilst furthering their debating and entrepreneurial skills. Our students participate in a number of competitions, receiving many prizes and commendations. Some of the competitions that our students have excelled in include: The Toastmasters Speaking Competition, the EuroMath Competition, the Kangourou Competition in English, French, Greek, ICT and Mathematics, the Greek Embassy Essay Writing Competition, the



French AMOPA Competitions, the Russian Poetry Competition, and the Stockholm Water Competition. The Heritage Private School always welcomes new practices and new approaches to learning for both teachers and students and encourages participation in educational research programmes.
