Project description: In 2019, The Club GENSartuppeuse ESSEC BS & others organized a first TechforGood Hakathon Under the aegis of Women’s Forum to help startups express, promote and measure the Impact of their projects on the United Nations’ Sustainable Development Goals. This hackathon involved more than a hundred participants, including 12 of Startups members of the Club and more than 60 experts members pf the club or partners . Startupeuses had 5 hours to present their project's impact, based on the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals. Several training we organised before since 5 months

The idea of the SwafS-26-2020 project would be to implement this innovative approach at a European scale by structuring and consolidating a network of experts and ecosystems in various disciplines and sectors (Business development, coaching, communication, digital/data, marketing, human resources, UX Design but moreover impact ...), and by organizing such hackathons at the European level and even further looking towards the Mediterranean area, with the support of digital technologies, with the final aim to bridge the gender gap in Entrepreneurship and promote projects having positive impact on our society and planet.
