1) PROJECT INFORMATION

Field of expertise related to the topic:

- 1) Cnam Pays de la Loire's main mission is to provide trainings to adults. Cnam has therefore a strong expertise in developing trainings tailored to a specific public and build a pedagogy suitable to its needs.
- 2) Cnam Pays de la Loire has a culture of scientific research and is familiar with the research community. Indeed, Cnam's training offer is based on the research carried out by the research professors of the Cnam network.
- 3) Using non-traditional forms is also a specificity of Cnam Pays de la Loire's Scientific and technical culture (STC) department, headed by Xavier Noel, which implements innovative activities that contribute to the acquisition of knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to participate in profound

changes engendered by scientific and technological developments inherent in the evolution of society. It is the first Cnam's center in terms of scientific and technical diffusion and it works closely with the Museum of Arts and Crafts and the Science, Technology and Society laboratory.

4) Moreover Cnam with its TICE department -which aims at promoting the integration of ICT (Information and Communication Technologies for Education and Training), is very much acquainted with all the medias involved in the acquisition of knowledge. Creating learning/training material, e-learning courses, videos, using the social media is part of TICE's activity.

5) Cnam's also has a department aimed at accompanying career paths called PAP. Its role is to support professional developments: social advancement, career management, professional mobility, professional integration, vocational guidance, cultural expansion ... The aim is to develop a coherent and effective individual professional project.

The research professors, STC, TICE and PAP departments are used to work together to produce efficient training materials and pedagogies.

- 2) At the level of training the researchers: to create training materials whatever digital or non-traditional with a system of update
- 3) To bring an independant point of view on the whole project and on ethics/integrity concerns due to a position at the crossroads of academic and business research and a strong culture of scientific research
