Together with the Austrian Alpenverein we started the initiative to **release Austria's nature from waste**. The aim of the project is to offer citizens an attractive tool to spot waste found in the nature with help of an App and to clean-up in person. The scientific part is the collection of open source data and to discover the amounts and different categories of waste – to plan measures (e.g. to contact producers of plastic bottles or cans) and to inform citizens about the problem in our nature (e.g. entry in groundwater, risk of injury for animals).
