Our proposal intends to bridge the existing gap between research findings, teaching practices and education policies by aligning existing a) research groups at universities carrying out their action at schools with b) identified key areas of interest from decision-makers right across Europe.

Potential contribution to the project:

EU funding would allow us to detect and finance specific research areas of common interest among partners across Europe, which would aid administrations base their educational policies on a more scientific-grounded base. Such research areas could include the assessment of:

- Second / Foreign / Minority language policies
- Innovative Methodologies (e.g. Multiple Intelligence Theory)

- Architecture at schools and its relationship with new methodologies
