1) **PROJECT INFORMATION**

Field of expertise related to the topic:

Vlerick Business School is determined to leverage its knowledge, contacts and insights as an international business school to support ambitious women in their careers. In our mission to better understand the drivers of gender (in)equality, the school has been involved in various projects regarding gender equality under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Katleen De Stobbeleir. In these projects, Vlerick Business School played a pivotal role in the execution and finalisation of said projects.

The most notable projects are:

- (2016) "A study on pregnancy discrimination", commissioned by the institute of gender equality. In this study, Vlerick Business School is currently researching a nation-wide sample of Belgian mothers regarding pregnancy discrimination in Belgium.
- (2016) Launch of the first *Executive Program for Female Leaders* in Belgium. Based on the insights of our research and projects concerning gender and career trajectories, Vlerick Business School has constructed a course for female leaders who want to get ahead on the corporate ladder. Already more than 21 companies participated in this program.
- (2014-2015) "Gender and Career Transitions", issued by the European Social Fund. In this project, Vlerick Business School researched a range of explicit and implicit obstacles (on a personal, organizational and societal level) that prevent women from advancing in their careers. In a second phase of the project, three teaching cases and a manual was written for organisations and individuals to assess and solve these obstacles.
- (2014-2015) "Authenticity and leadership" (CICI funding). In this project, Vlerick Business School created and gave authenticity workshops to female leaders in order to help them overcome the "double bind" situation in their companies. These workshops are still being given by Flanders DC.

Additionally, Vlerick Business School is active in various local and national networks that enables us to cross-fertilise and disseminate our insights from these projects. For example, Prof. Dr. Katleen De Stobbeleir is member of the board of directors of the VOV learning network. Moreover, the Vlerick campus in Brussels is used for the yearly <u>Wo.men@work</u> event (organized by JUMP), where the Womed award is presented to a c-level executive in Belgium who had a significant





positive impact on the gender equality in Belgium. Vlerick Business School plays an important role as a partner in both of these happenings. On a more local level, the school is active in various networks like "straffe madammen", "crosstalks", JUMP and regularly attends networking sessions that are organised by IVGM, Amon and Catalyst. This has enabled the school to build out a national presence and establish itself as an expert on gender equality in practice.

Potential contribution to the project:

Given the broad presence of the school in Belgium (i.e. Ghent, Brussels and Leuven), our extended network of business contacts (e.g. active alumni network of 19.000 contacts) and our close collaboration with companies and various research institutions, we believe to be an ideal partner to represent Belgium in a European collaboration to share and research gender related issues. Some of the contributions we can make in such projects are (but not limited to):

- The organisation of networking events at one of our campuses
- Participation in national and international research activities
- Content related contributions to projects or tools.
- Dissemination of insights, projects, tools, ... in our network.
- Training of representatives (internal and/or external) in our training facilities, by our international faculty members.
